Shades of Blue (Varsity)

Shades of Blue is the premier contemporary a cappella group at Bradley High School. This group is open to students of all grades from any Bradley choir. **Shades of Blue is a cocurriuclar group.** This group meets daily 8th period Monday - Friday and will also have one or more after school rehearsal per week. Students <u>must</u> have a period free in their schedule. If accepted, students will be added to **Chamber Ensemble.** (It is a requirement that students are also in a curricular choir). Students accepted will also be expected to attend Jaguar A Cappella Camp in July. Performances will be varied throughout the school year including major performances at Hilliard Idol and Jaguar A Cappella concerts. Shades of Blue also competes each year in the International Championship of High School A Cappella which runs from January through April and records their own music. **Next year Shades of Blue will again be competing in ICHSA.** Shades of Blue is directed by Mr. Witt, Ms. Burkett, and Ms. Schott

ECHO (JV A)

ECHO is a mixed a cappella group and is open to students of all grades enrolled in any Bradley Choir. Students who attend Tolles may also audition even if they cannot be in a curricular choir. WAVE (JV B)

All rehearsals will be after school. Students accepted will also be expected to attend Jaguar A Cappella Camp in July. Performances will be varied throughout the school year including major performances at Hilliard Idol and Jaguar A Cappella Concerts. Students in WAVE are expected to work on music outside of rehearsals and come to rehearsals well prepared. WAVE may compete in the International Championship of High School A Cappella which runs from January through April. WAVE is directed by Ms. Schott.

AUDITION PROCESS

Solo Audition

Solo auditions will occur the first two scheduled audition days (March 18th + 20th 2024). March 18th will be at Memorial for current 8th graders. March 20th will be at Bradley for current high school students. You will have a scheduled 3 minute audition slot where you will sing a pop song a cappella. Audition sign ups will be available on sign up genius. Students will be asked to sing one verse and one chorus of their song (approx. 1 minute) however, you may be asked to sing more of the song (a 'pop song' includes almost every style of music excluding classical and musical theater). Auditionees are encouraged to pick music they listen to in their free time and a song that best showcases their voice. Students will receive an email notifying them if they are receiving a callback audition.

Middle School Solo Auditions will be Monday March 18th from 3pm-4:30pm Memorial Middle School Choir Room

High School Solo Auditions will be Wednesday March 20th from 3pm-4:30pm Bradley High School Choir Room

Callback Audition

Callbacks will occur after the solo auditions (**Friday March 22nd, 2024**). Students will be notified by email about callbacks. Due to the nature of of putting together three groups of voices, it is a requirement to attend callbacks for the full duration to be placed in a group. Those who have received a callback will have one full day to prepare a song provided by the directors. **Students should learn the part specified by the directors in the callback email** (Some students may be asked to learn multiple parts). Sheet music as well as learning tracks will be provided and students are encouraged to work together to prepare. It is an <u>expectation</u> that you come to callbacks knowing your part extremely well. You are not required to have the song memorized, but you should know it well enough that you only need to glance at the music. Following the callbacks, the directors will announce a list of those students who have made each group.

PLEASE READ: What we are looking for in your audition: Strength of voice, tone quality, pitch, dynamics, range, confidence, emotion, and "stage presence". We are also looking to put together groups with a good **balance** of voices that will **blend** together and singing experience. Please understand that if you do not make it, there are many factors that go into choosing people for an a cappella group.

Rehearsal Commitment

Shades of Blue - Rehearsals are every Monday - Friday 8th period and Monday's 7-9pm

ECHO + WAVE - Rehearsals are Monday's 5:30pm - 7:00pm

As a member of a Jaguar A Cappella group there are attendance requirements. You will **not** be allowed to miss more than **one** unexcused rehearsals per semester. School sports, activities, and performances are excused absences, as described in the school handbook. Exceeding one unexcused absence during a school year will affect your eligibility for membership in a group. Please email the director 24 hours or more before the rehearsal as to your absence, and the reason for your absence. If you are sick, <u>please notify the director even if you missed school.</u> It is your responsibility to find out from someone in your section what you missed and get any rehearsal notes and information.

Financial Commitment

Fees: Participation in Jaguar A Cappella runs throughout the school year and is much like a **three season sport**. Due to this, we have fees to cover the cost of what we do throughout the year. The fees for participation in Shades of Blue are **\$250** and ECHO/WAVE are **\$175**. This fee covers the cost of purchasing arrangements for the group, t - shirts, food, performance equipment rentals, supplemental staffing, and clinicians. For example, each arrangement costs between \$400-\$800 dollars. Fees are due at the INFO Meeting for students on May 20th **2024** and are non-refundable after this date if a student leaves the group (Please make checks payable to Hilliard Music Boosters).

INFO Meetings 2024

If accepted into a group, we will hold informational meetings for students on **May 20th, 2024.** Fees are due for all members at this meeting. Cash or checks (made payable to Hilliard Music Boosters). The fees for participation in Shades of Blue are **\$250** and ECHO/WAVE are **\$175**. The camp fee (**\$75**) can be paid at this meeting or on the first day of camp in July.
